SHOW THE BEST 2016/17

THIRD QUARTER'S LEAGUE TABLE

The league table for the third quarter of the 2016/17 Show the Best competition is attached. The best performances are shown for all members who have completed at least one race at a qualifying distance but, to be ranked, four qualifying distances need to have been completed. The best four performances for each qualifying member have been highlighted in red and these are the percentages which give the average in the end column.

The best individual performance in the second quarter was Glynn Davis's 81.40% for the Cubert 5 (actual time 30:12). The best individual performance by a female member was Meryl Elstone's 71.05% for same race (actual time 38:07).

The leader of the competition this quarter is Glynn Davis with an average percentage of 81.39% who has increased his lead over Paul Sawford who is in second place with an average percentage of 79.59% and Barrie Cardew remains in third place with an average percentage of 77.20%. The top female member is Meryl Elstone who is in eighth place overall with an average percentage of 71.49% with Sandy Jamieson the second placed female with an average percentage of 71.14%.

There are forty nine members who have qualified in the third quarter compared with thirty nine who qualified in the third quarter of last year. Apart from these members there are seventy two members who have completed at least one qualifying distance and, of these, nine have completed three, eighteen have completed two and forty five have completed one. These will all have to have completed four qualifying races to be ranked in the final table at 31 October. All other members who have not raced at a qualifying distance since 1 November 2016 will also need to have completed four races at qualifying distances to be ranked in the final table.

The actual times which give the percentages in the league table are shown in the summary attached to the table. If a member has any queries on the times shown please refer them to me.

I can confirm that I monitor all the road and multi terrain grand prix results and any other major races within Cornwall (using the Tamar Trotters results page) but, if any member does a race over one of the qualifying distances out of county or a minor race in Cornwall, it would be helpful if you let me know your result in order that I can include it in the tables. I also monitor the Penrose parkrun results but would like you to let me know if you do any other parkrun.
